#### Anti-social behaviour in the village

Prior to the formal start of the meeting, Tracey Baxter from the BDC Anti-Social Behaviour Team gave a talk on how the unit tackles anti-social behaviour by young people in general, and how this is being applied in Shipdham.

It was proposed by Cllr Fawcett and seconded by Cllr Ralph that the minutes were a true representation of the meeting. All agreed and the Chairman signed the minutes.

#### **Chairman's Annual Report**

Cllr. Chubbock outlined the work of the Parish Council and highlighted the following achievements for the 2011-2012 year:

- restoration of the church wall
- provision of a play area at Bullock Park
- resurfacing of the Village Green
- setting up the new Village Website
- finalising of the LDF
- provision of NALC training for all Councillors and the Clerk.

The Old School Playing field problem still needs a solution. There have been incidents of antisocial behaviour and vandalism perpetrated by youngsters in the Village, and the police and BDC anti-social behaviour unit are actively involved in resolving the problems. In the coming year the Parish Council will be tackling the replacement of street lights, a plan for the extension of the Cemetery, more ways to use the website, speed monitoring in the village and looking at introducing improved ways of transacting Council business.

#### Parish Accounts for 20011/2012

The Parish Accounts were available for Parishioners to view, and had been signed off by the Parish Council. The Chairman would now look for an Internal Auditor to review the accounts prior to sending the Annual Return to the External Auditors.
