

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order affecting the 1) BR15 (3R0853) from a point 195 metres northeast of its junction with A1075 Watton Road to its junction with footpath BR16; and 2) BR16 (3R0854) from its junction with footpath BR15 to its junction with U31172 Parklands Avenue; in the PARISH OF SHIPDHAM because of works to construct new dwellings.

The footpaths 1) and 2) will be temporarily closed (except for access) from 2nd June 2020 to 2nd December 2020 for the duration of the works, expected to be 207days within the period.

Alternative route is not available.


(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 6 months from the date of the Order).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
