

Staying safe: staying connected

This second guide issues by the Shipdham Emergency Planning Team builds on the leaflet delivered to all residents a week ago and updates current guidance, information and advice during the COVID-19 outbreak.

As a village we are in a second week of lockdown. It is important to know that help is out there, and no one should feel alone. Please keep yourself and your family safe and also look out for the wellbeing of neighbours. Give them a phone call if you can. We will get through this and remain strong as a community, just as Shipdham residents have done so for hundreds of years.

Organisations are contacting people via email and SMS messages on your phone. NO ORGANISATION WILL ASK YOU FOR MONEY OR SUGGEST YOU ARE RECEIVING SOME VIA A LINK ON YOUR PHONE OR THROUGH PHONE CALLS. If you are not absolutely clear who you are talking to, hang up and call the main number above, or anyone that you know well. Do not fall to a scam.

Call for volunteers

We need people to volunteer to drop things off safely and pick things up as part of a daily exercise routine for those who cannot leave home. Contact the main number above.

If you need urgent provisions

If you are unable to leave home and have no neighbours/relatives who can help, we can arrange to deliver an emergency provision bag to you from the local village Post Office Shop. See the reverse for details. Please note that we are not a home shopping service, and the products are limited. We will try our best to help but might not always get it right. Please be patient.

Shipdham Post Office emergency provision bag

All products are subject to availability. If a product is not available a substitute will be provided. Tins include a soup, beans, sweetcorn or equivalent. Vegetables and fruit will be a small selection of what is available. We cannot accept returns for substitutes, sorry: if you get something you don't like, try it and if you are hungry enough, you will eat it!

Bags are ordered either through the main number in the Staying safe: Staying connected leaflet (repeated overleaf), the tear-off slip, or from this form, left on your door for the postie to collect. You will be contacted to confirm the order and the delivery period. Bags cost a maximum of £10 delivered depending on whether you choose 1l or 2l of milk, or want pet food. The actual amount charged for the actual products in the bag will be charged to you in your Parish Council nominee account. You can pay us back as a council after the outbreak has finished, or contact the main number if you wanted to pay earlier by cheque or direct bank transfer.
