Introduction

Our primary function is to provide additional funds to support the work of Thomas Bullock School. We are able to use any remaining funds available to us "in furthering the education (including religious education in accordance with the doctrines of the Church of England and social and physical training) of young residents in the parish of Shipdham" who "are in need of financial assistance in such ways as the Trustees think fit." The Trustees meet at least twice a year.

Qualifications for a Grant

In order to qualify for a grant:

- *either* you must be under the age of 21 years at the time of your application *or* you must represent an organisation catering for the needs of local young people under the age of 21 years;
- *and* you must make the application before the start date for the activity or purpose;
- *and* you must share with us any documentary evidence that you have to demonstrate that you will be participating in the activity or purpose for which you are applying.

For longer-term activities or purposes, a new application must be made each year.

Deadlines

The deadline for applications for University grants is 31 August, and the deadline for applications for Further Education grants is 30 September. Any application for either of these purposes received after the relevant deadline will be reluctantly rejected.

Application for Grants

Your application must be made to our Treasurer, Dave Kent, using this Grant Application Form. The form may be completed by hand and then posted or hand-delivered or scanned and e-mailed; or the form may be completed electronically and then e-mailed or sent via Facebook.
