Introduction

The Thomas Bullock Charity provides additional funds to support the work of the Thomas Bullock Primary School. However, in addition to this main function, it is able to use any remaining funds available 'in furthering the education (including religious education in accordance with the doctrines of the Church of England and social and physical training) of residents in the parish of Shipdham who have not attained the age of 25 years and are in need of financial assistance in such ways as the Trustees think fit' (extract from the terms of the Charity Scheme)

Meetings of the seven trustees are held at least twice each year and applications for financial assistance should be made to the Hon Treasurer, Mr Geoff Hinchliffe (details below).

If you want to apply for financial support for an activity which satisfies the above criteria, you must usually be under the age of 21 years at the time of application, or represent an organisation catering for the needs of local young people under the age of 25 years.

Applications must be submitted in advance of the activity,(where applicable) by one of these deadlines: 30th April, 31st August (eg for university grants), 30th September (FE grants) or 31st December.

Where appropriate, supporting evidence must be attached to the application form.
